Leadership Frisco is a learning experience that requires attendance and extracurricular activities. To graduate from the program, I understand that the following will be required:

- Attend the inaugural retreat, September 8th and 9th, (Friday afternoon/evening – Saturday full day) including a "Challenge by Choice Ropes Course". After the inaugural retreat, no class member may miss more than one (1) full session plus 2 hours or the total of ten (10) hours of class work to qualify for graduation. *SEE ATTENDANCE ADDENDUM.
- Upon Graduation, I agree to be an active participant in the Leadership Frisco Alumni Association.

Calendar of Class Dates

The calendar of class dates is published as a separate document, and is part of the Application Instructions as well. Applicants are encouraged to review the calendar of class dates to ensure they understand the time commitment and proposed dates for each class. Class members are expected to attend each class day, and participate in community meetings that might be required as homework for class or for project completion.

Class Fee
