- Exceed employment standards and safety policies
- Model integrity and excellent communication skills
- Exhibits genuine interest in well-being of employees

Developer of the Year

- Have broken ground or completed a recent development in Frisco within the past year (commercial, residential, non-profit, or educational)
- Provide outstanding quality of products and services
- Represent innovative design elements

Entrepreneur of the Year

- Demonstrate leadership and creativity
- Represent innovative ideas
- Demonstrate personal and financial commitment

Non-Profit of the Year

- Organization demonstrates outstanding contribution to the community
- Show benefits of service and how they set their organization apart
- Provide measurable results of program initiatives
- Spend at least 75% of budget on program expenses

Volunteer of the Year

- Be an individual whose volunteer activities benefit the Frisco Chamber of Commerce, City of Frisco, and/or the surrounding community in a significant, positive, or unique way
- Volunteer activity must have occurred within the last year

Young Professional of the Year

- Must be between the ages of 21 and 45
- Volunteer with the Frisco Chamber of Commerce, City of Frisco, and/or surrounding community
- Demonstrate strong leadership skills

All nominees must be a member in good standing with the Frisco Chamber of Commerce for one full year as of 10/31/2020.
